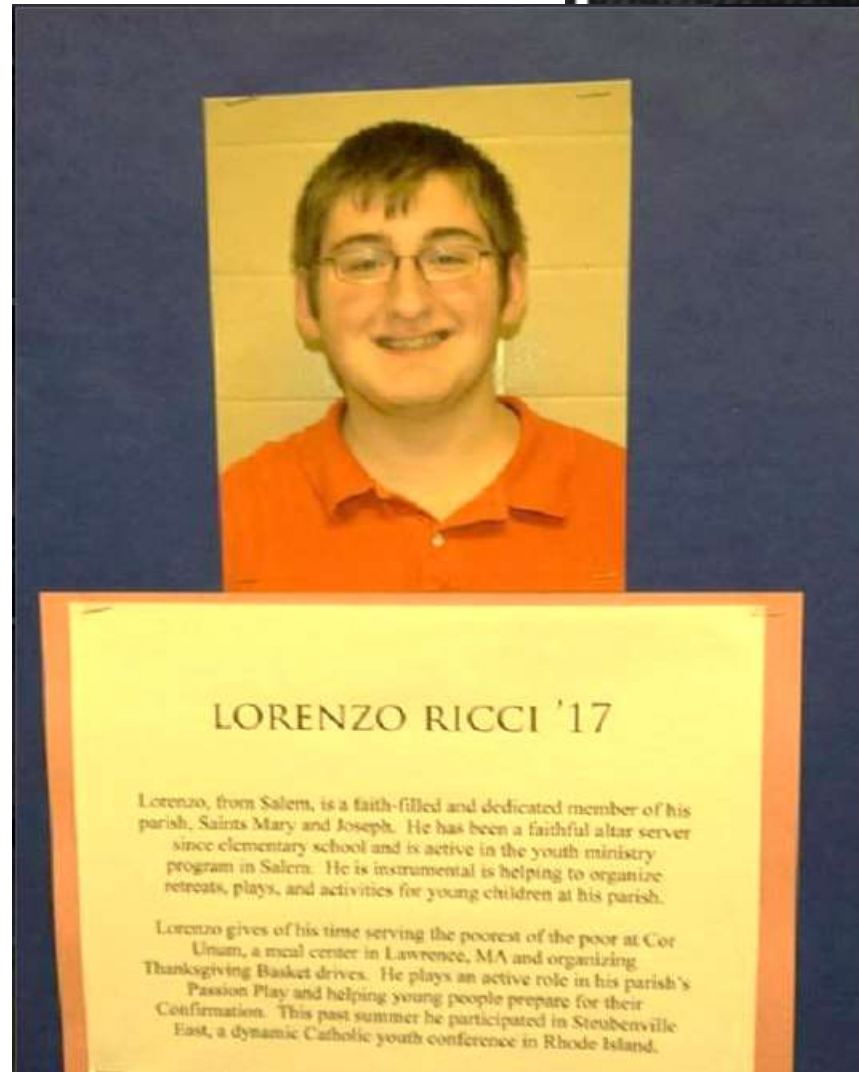


# Lorenzo Joseph Ricci Class of 2013

member of the community.



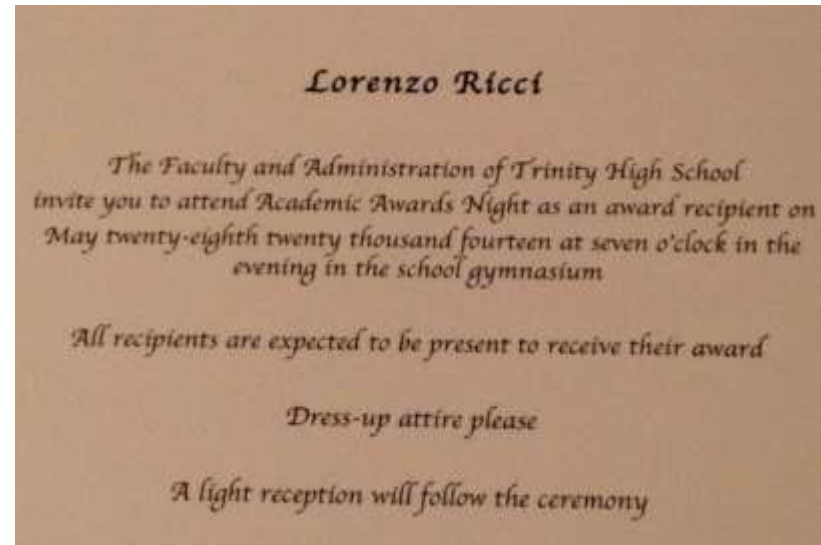
Lorenzo is part of the Youth Ministry core group at Saints Mary and Joseph Parish, Salem, NH.

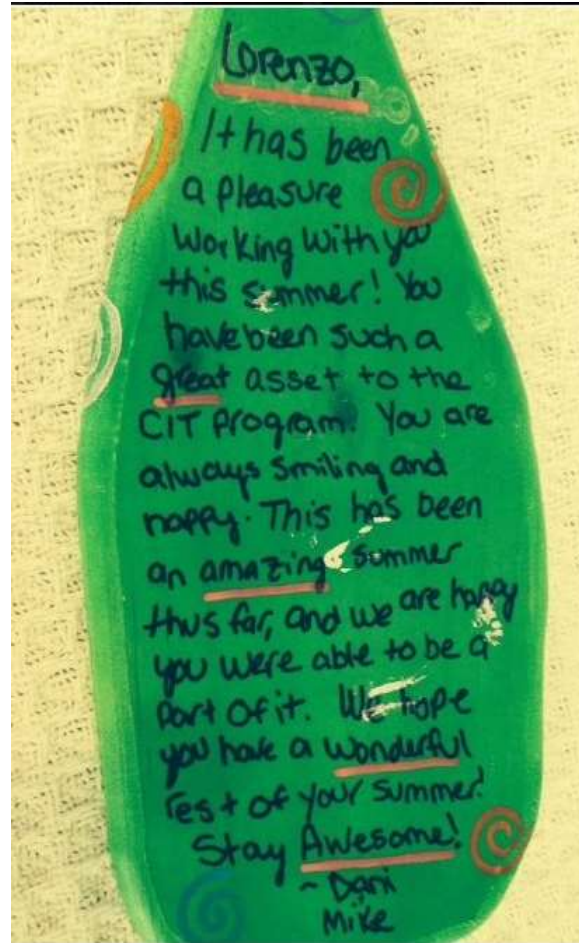


Lorenzo presenting to the Parish Council and confirmation candidates about the Saints Mary and Joseph Parish Youth Ministry.

As the participant in the program, we are interested in hearing from you when there are questions or concerns. I know your parents may want to help by completing forms, calling me, and asking Kristina questions. Work with your parents to get the job done with you at the helm. You need to be taking initiative to get the work done.

You will need to complete the online application accessible through our website after January 2. Everyone needs to submit and updated health form. You also need to obtain an Underage Working Permit from your School's Principal which is required because this is a volunteer position. New Hampshire residents should coordinate this with your School's Principal. If you do not live in New Hampshire, please contact me to arrange your permit from a New Hampshire School under NH DOL regulations.

If you are not interested in the program, please return the form with "no" checked off.
