Frequently Asked Questions

What is the maximum class size?

Our maximum class size is 20, although most days it is less. Ratio 10:1

Do the children wear uniforms?

Yes, we wear gym uniforms every day with sneakers.

Do the children have snack?

Yes. We ask parents to donate a variety of snacks and drinks, so that we may offer the children a few choices each day.

What do I do for lunch?

Students have lunch in the cafeteria. A menu is sent home each month. Children may purchase a hot lunch or bring in a lunch from home. Milk is also offered each day.

Can my half day child stay for lunch?

Yes. We do have an additional fee for staying extra hours.

What time is the earliest I can drop off or the latest I can pick up my child?

You can drop off as early as 8:00 am and pick up is by 3:15pm. The before-care and after-care program is available at St. Joseph’s from 7:00 am until 6:00 pm for an additional fee. Please ask for details.
