2. Apply for financial aid through FACTS. The required forms are [available on the FACTS website](#) or in our Main Office.
3. Apply for a scholarship through the Children's Scholarship Fund. Information and links on how to apply are [available on our website](#).

Once the appropriate paperwork has been received, it will be reviewed by our administration. The family will be contacted and informed of the decision and/or their next step. Financial aid is determined on a needs basis.

Financial Aid

St. Joseph Regional Catholic School uses the FACTS Tuition Management Program to allow parents to apply for financial aid. Along with the financial aid application, FACTS requires supporting documentation (current tax, W-2 forms, and previous year tax return) when determining eligibility. School Choice Scholarship Act

The Network for Educational Opportunity (NEO) has now joined with the Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF).
