Dear St. Joseph Regional Catholic School Community,

With the rapidly evolving circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 situation, the Superintendent, in conjunction with Bishop Libasci, has decided that Catholic Schools in New Hampshire should move to a remote learning model until March 27th. The exact day of initial remote learning will depend on each individual school and what's happening in that locale.

The health and safety of our community is a priority and I take it very seriously. In order for our students and families to be fully prepared for the online learning experience, we will have school on Monday and Tuesday. This will allow teachers to discuss plans with students, handout necessary materials and explain expectations.

As always, if your child is sick, has had a fever or vomitted within 24 hours of the school day, please keep them home. Some of our teachers will be attending a training at the diocese on Monday and Tuesday so that they can then train other faculty more fully on Google Classroom. We will be utilizing a combination of Google Classroom, paper packages (in the primary grades) and the FACTS SIS Family Portal for online learning purposes.

Due to this latest development, I have also decided to postpone the Gala. The auction committee, Mrs. Latino and I will be working closely with the venue and other service providers to ensure that the event, that so many have worked so hard on, will come to a successful fruition in the near future. Watch for an announcement from the auction committee on Monday.

Please continue to pray that this situation resolves itself soon, as we work together as a community, albeit remotely, to continue educating our St. Joe's students.
