- FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIP FACT SHEET -

Our mission at St. Joseph Regional Catholic School is to challenge and motivate all students to reach their full potential in mind, spirit, heart, and body. **We want to help families provide the gift of a Catholic education to their children.** St. Joe's provides financial assistance to families in need. The amount of available funds varies each year. Interested families should apply each year. All information will be held in the strictest confidence.

Here are the options available to our school families:

1. Our multi-child discount is available to families with two or more students in K-8. See our Tuition sheet for details.
2. Apply for financial aid through FACTS. The application is available online, [on the FACTS website](#). Note: your child(ren) must be enrolled in our school in order to apply. *Application will open for '22/'23 school year on April 30, 2022.*
3. Apply for a scholarship through the Children's Scholarship Fund. This scholarship is open to current students entering kindergarten or grade one **and** is open to students in K-8 who transfer from a public school. 4. 529 Savings Plan: The 2017 Tax Cut and Jobs Act expanded 529 savings plans to allow families to invest funds for K12 tuition in addition to higher education expenses. [Click here for more information](#).

Financial Aid St. Joseph Regional Catholic School uses the FACTS Tuition Management Program to allow parents to apply for financial aid. Along with the financial aid application, FACTS requires supporting documentation (current tax, W-2 forms, and previous year tax return) when determining eligibility.
